Elizabeth (Betty) Hale, longtime resident of Cheney WA was born to pioneers Martha and John Baylor at Colfax, WA on March 6, 1913. She graduated from Colfax High School in 1929 and attended Cheney Normal School. After graduation Mrs Hale taught school in Seattle for four years until her marriage to Millard E. Hale of Sandpoint Idaho. The Hales lived in Sandpoint and Grangeville before returning to Cheney in 1941. Mrs Hale worked as a field representative for Royal Neighbors Life Insurance and also worked part time for the Cheney Telephone Company. After the death of her husband in 1967, Betty worked full time for the telephone company until her retirement in 1978. Betty enjoyed travel with friends and family. She also enjoyed Bridge, and belonged to two Bridge clubs for years. She was also an animal lover and enjoyed a succession of pet dogs and cats. Mrs Hale was a longtime member of the Cheney United Methodist Church, the Royal Neighbors, East Cheney Grange and a member of the Eastern Star since 1945.
