Margaret Luella Honegger, 93, went to be with her Lord on January 14, 2018. The daughter of Ole and Nellie (Johnson) Reinholt, she was born in Lansford, North Dakota on December 26, 1924.

She was raised in Minot, North Dakota until the family moved to Spokane, Washington during Margaret's senior year. She stayed in Minot with friends until she graduated, later joining her family in Spokane.
