LaShaw (Fougere), Genevieve (Age 97) passed away peacefully on February 4, 2021. She was born on July 2, 1923, in Cambridge, MA, where she was raised with her two siblings. Genevieve attended St. Mary's Parochial School, graduating in 1940. At the age of 20, she entered the United States Marine Corps and served from 1943-1945, working at the Post Exchange. Genevieve stayed at home to raise their five girls and help on the farm. She enjoyed sewing and cooking and was the choir director at St. Joseph's Church. She is survived by four daughters, Ceci (John) Richardson; Mary (Rod) Jacot; Phyllis (Dan) Rockstrom and Jackie (Brian) Faire; nine grandchildren, 21 great-grandchildren, and one great-great-grandchild, as well as her brother, Eddie Fougere.
