Alexander (Alex) Ralph Bulat, age 73, of Cheney, WA passed away on the afternoon of November 16, 2015 at Hospice House of Spokane, after a long battle with cancer. Alex was born on June 6, 1942 to Sam and Ann (Medved) Bulat in Aliquippa, PA. He married Linda (Lin) Redding on November 10, 1961 in Dillon, South Carolina. Alex joined the US Air Force with the dream of becoming a pilot. He served in the 95th Civil Engineering Squadron.
