Bob was the proud owner of a 1940 Ford Deluxe Sedan and enjoyed being a member of the Dukes Auto Club of Spokane, and the Slicks of Medical Lake. He and Renee’ formed many long-lasting friendships with members of these car clubs. Bob took great pride and pleasure in coordinating Rod runs for his friends and used his great organizational skills to create memorable events.
