



## Gina Marie Hollingsworth

July 16, 1969 - May 13, 2023

Gina Marie Hollingsworth (Muñoz), Age 53, passed away peacefully on May 13th, 2023, at her home in Spokane, WA. This came to pass unexpectedly, despite many years of living with various chronic medical complications. She is survived by: former spouse Michael Marquez, and two non-binary children Rebecca Marquez and Samwell Marquez, as well as former spouse Jerald Hollingsworth, and son Jerald Hollingsworth Junior. Gina will be dearly missed by her brothers Gregorio Munoz III, Gary Munoz, and Gilbert Munoz. She will additionally be missed by her close sisters-in-law Cathy Munoz, Lisa Coleman Corean, and Maria Munoz, as well as by her nephew Gilbert Munoz Jr. and niece Gabriella Munoz. She was preceded in death by her parents Vernice Munoz (Olson) and Gregorio Munoz Jr.

Gina Hollingsworth was born July 16th, 1969 in San Bernardino, CA. She lived in and traveled to many various places around the world growing up and throughout her career. Both as a military brat child, and later as an adult military spouse working in the civilian service, she greatly valued her close family-ties, as she often traveled and moved. As a young adult, she began work for the government at a travel agency in Castle Air Force Base, before finishing her education in Court Reporting and Stenography in Fresno, CA in 1989. She received her license in Washington State in 1992, and began contract court reporting work at Royal Air Force Lakenheath, England. Returning to Washington State, she was hired on as a court reporter for 92nd

Judge Advocates Office at Fairchild Air Force Base, 1998 to 2002, then at Hanscom Air Force Base 2002 to 2005, and then Bolling Air Force Base in Washington DC, 2005 to 2010. An accomplished court reporter, she built up her career further in Germany, working on cases and legal documents for the Department of Justice. Gina was entrusted with sensitive information and Top-Secret security clearance for court reporting and transcription work as a GS-10 civilian. Later, after injuries to her hands, she transitioned to work as a witness advocate before eventually retiring in 2014. She most recently moved back to Washington State to be near her family again. Her three adult children, her family, and all of her dogs were her greatest joys. Memories of Gina Hollingsworth will be treasured for her bright fire, her sense of fun, and her big, easy laugh. Gina will be laid to rest at Fairview Cemetery in Cheney, WA, close to her parents' resting place.
