Henry Blaze Seipp passed away Thursday, June 9, 2022. Hank was born March 20, 1967, to William A. and Virginia R. Seipp in Aberdeen, Washington. He and his twin, Robert, began their lives notably, as the first recorded twins born in the Aberdeen/Ocean Shores area. Hank graduated from Cheney High and from the Job Core. As a younger man, Hank was a commercial fisherman, a painter, a chef, and worked in property management. Later, Hank became a commercial Real Estate Agent and Broker. His latest endeavor was opening Trovato Interiors with the love of his life, Susan Usai.

Hank had a passion for the outdoors, for wildlife, and particularly wolves. His connection with wolves ran deep. He would often journey to the mountain to enjoy their peace and feel their spirit. He wrote about the wolves in "Today as I Run" and "The Wolf Within."
