Our family is deeply saddened to announce the passing of Jeffrey Alan McClure, age 62. He passed peacefully on November 5th, surrounded by his children.

Jeff was born on April 6, 1960, at Chelsea Naval Hospital in Massachusetts to Kreston and Mary McClure. After graduating from Medical Lake High School in 1978, he went on to study Archaeology at Eastern Washington University.
