Linda, 77, of Fairfield, WA, was born in Spokane, WA, to Carl and Arleen (Wichman) Hofmann and was the eldest of four daughters. She grew up on the family farm by Plaza, WA, and graduated from Liberty High School, Spangle, WA, in 1964. After high school, she attended Kinman Business School and graduated with a business and bookkeeping degree in 1965. She married Larry Cupp in 1965. They resided in Mt Hope, WA, farming while raising their family of three children, Kevin, Karmin, and Kasie. Linda did a multitude of activities and various jobs in the community and church along with continuing her passion for singing and music.

While in high school she enjoyed numerous activities including cheerleading, singing with the Liberty Bells, and choir. Music and singing were a big part of Linda's entire life. In her younger years, she sang at many community events. Throughout her life, she was asked to sing solos at numerous events including weddings and funerals. She also taught singing and piano and led a children's choir for the Memorial Day services at Mt Hope Church. She was involved in the annual Fairfield Flag Day musical productions for many years on stage singing and performing. Her home hobbies included knitting and sewing beautiful items along with numerous crafts.

She was a member of the Dishman Baptist "Born Again" musical group that

sang at many events in the Spokane areas and prisons. Linda had a strong Christian faith and was always ready to help spread the word of God by witnessing to others.

She also worked at the Fairfield Good Samaritan Nursing Home as the activity director, bookkeeper at Cornwall Machinery, and insurance adjuster for FBA Insurance. Later she turned the FBA into a legacy for scholarships. She owned and operated LC Accounting for many years. Larry passed away in 2008 after 43 years of marriage. Linda married Darrell Flaig in 2011. They enjoyed farming, gardening, traveling, and spending their winters in Arizona with family and friends.

Linda is survived by her husband, Darrell, and children: Kevin (Maylynn) Cupp, Karmin Johnson, and Kasie Cupp. Sisters: Phyllis (Lowell) Schuman, Carol (Jim) Kraft, and Leisa (Jeff) Sorensen.
