Lorraine Marcene (Hess) Flikke of Cheney, Washington passed away September 11, 2014 in Spokane. She was born July 7, 1919 in Deer Lodge, MT. and grew up in Coeur d'Alene and Rathdrum, ID. In 1938, she graduated from Rathdrum High School and married Leland Flikke in Newport, WA. Lee and Lorraine purchased and operated the general store in Westmond, ID in their early years before Lee went into the Army Airforce. They settled in Spokane and purchased a grocery store on Nevada St. called Flikke's Grocery and another store on Northwest Blvd. In 1955 with the advent of the supermarket, the small neighborhood grocery stores closed and Lee and Lorraine moved to Cheney where Lee delivered milk door to door for Darigold, and Lorraine was a "cream tester." Lorraine lived in Cheney until her death; the last 5 years at Cheney Assisted Living with all her friends. Lorraine is survived by her Children; Jerry Flikke (Karen) of Spokane, WA and Marcene Hendrickson (Paul) of Dayton, WA. Eight grandchildren, ten great-grandchildren and five nieces and nephews.
