Mitchell David Moczulski, age 87, of Cheney, Washington, passed away on Saturday, April 14th. Mitchell was born on August 7, 1938, in Cleveland, Ohio, to Mitchell and Helen Moczulski.

He graduated from John Adams High School and married his high school sweetheart, Mary Jane Pocisk, at age 18.
